Our courses

Abbey View 9 hole golf course 1411 yards Par 29

All members of the public are welcome at Abbey View, which is operated on a pay and play basis and is open all year round. The course was established in 1990 and has been growing ever since. Abbey View is highly regarded as a fine 9 hole golf course with some beautiful views of surrounding areas that can be seen from all areas of the course. The course is aimed at the young, the short of time, the beginner or those looking to tighten up their short game.

Tots development

Tots 1 – Aimed at 3 to 5 year olds

The aim of these courses is to provide an opportunity for pre-school children to become co-ordinated at ball skills using mini Golf Clubs and to develop key motor skills. The Tot's courses will take your children through a number of different games and exercises focused on hitting targets. Parental involvement is a must on all Tots courses.

Course: 3 - 5 Years

Abbey View junior club development

Competitions will run on the first Saturday of every month. Children will have the chance to compete against players of a similar age and ability. (Parental guidance advised.)

Saturday at Abbey View is "JUNIOR TIME". Just turn up at 4pm, pay your fee and meet other children who are keen to test their skills over the challenging 9 hole course layout.

Junior development

Intermediate level

This course is designed to improve your shot making skills and you will learn how to play shots around the green, putting and reading the green. Mark will teach you short chipping shots over 20 - 50 yards and Mark will also introduce you to playing shots from the sand.

Courses: 6 years+
Saturday 12:00 - 12:45

Peak performance level

This course is designed to develop skills from the first 2 levels and will introduce your child to playing the game. Focus will be on etiquette and course management. Mark will hope that by the end of this level your child will have developed a full swing, will have varied shot-making ability, will be able to read the green and will be able to navigate round a Golf Course.

Adult development

Beginner level

This course is designed to introduce adults to the game of golf. Mark will run through your setup to include grip, stance and body posture. In addition Mark will begin to teach the basic swing.

Course: 16 years+

Saturdays 10:00 - 11:00

Intermediate level

This course is designed to improve your shot making skills and you will learn to play shots around the green, putting and reading the green. Mark will teach you short chipping shots over 50 - 90 yards and Mark will also introduce you to playing shots from the sand.

Course: 16 years+

Saturdays 11:00 - 12:00

Senior golf development

40+ Session

This session is designed to cover all aspects of the game, from beginners to advance levels. No booking necessary, just come along and join in each week.

Course: 40 years+ Wednesday

10:30 - 11:30

Family Golf Development

This course is designed to encourage the family to learn the game of golf together. Mark will cover various aspects of the game including the general swing technique and Short game skills. This is ideal for newcomers and intermediate players.
